Please Read Before Registering

Skate Canada Fee

- All skaters must pay an annual Skate Canada membership fee of \$32.70
- This fee is required to be paid by skaters of a Skating School or Club sanctioned by Skate Canada.
- The membership is in affect from September 1, 2011 to August 31st, 2012. This fee will be added to your first registration of the 2011-2012 skating season.

If you register on line more than once within the 2011 – 2012 season, please mark on the registration form the box marked “Fee Paid 2011/2012”.

Parents or guardians of children 8 years of age and younger must be present during all classes

Helmets

- Helmets with Masks are mandatory for all skaters age 9 and younger registered in the following programs. Pre-School & Youth, Special Needs, CanSkate, Introductory Power
- Helmet required for all skaters until the skaters have passed CanSkate Level 5
- Helmet with Mask mandatory for all skaters in the Power Skating Programs

New To Skating

- If your child is new to skating, it is highly recommended that you bring your child to watch a program. Not all 3 or 4 year olds are ready to be on the ice without their parents.
- By watching a program, this will help to alleviate any first day anxieties.
- If your child is hesitant about joining in without a parent, you may want to wait a few months and then register.

Special Needs Skaters

- If your child has any special needs, please let us know at the time of registration. Any information that you can share with us, will help us to make your child's lessons enjoyable and safe.

Private Lessons

- Private lessons are available in some programs.
- These lessons are arranged between the skater/parent and the coach. Fees are determined by coaches' experience. Private lessons are arranged for the duration of the session
- Each private lesson is usually 15 minutes. Note on the registration in the request section that you would like private lessons and the coach name if you know it. If you do not have a coach in mind you may want to wait until the first class to see who you would like.

Cancellation Policy

- Programs cancelled within 2 weeks of the start of a program, will be charged the cancellation fee of \$30.00
- No refunds or credits after the start of the program.
- Any refunds to credit cards will be charged a \$10.00 administrative fee
- Credits will only be given for illness related absences upon receipt of a certified Doctor's note.

Bad Weather

- If program is to be cancelled due to bad weather Skaters First will contact you by email or telephone.

* Pre-School & Youth Learn To Skate CanSkate

CanSkate is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program, designed for beginners of all ages. CanSkate has 7 levels of skating skills.

Skaters First has taken the first 3 CanSkate levels and divided the skills into achievable levels for the younger skater. These are Pre-School & Youth Levels 1 – 7. Please see progression chart.

- Fun recreational learn to skate programs are for children and youth from ages 3 and up.
- Each 45 minutes lesson is designed to develop balance and on ice coordination.
- Using age appropriate music as well as toys, the skaters will be introduced to basic skating skills and will develop the confidence level necessary for further skill enhancement.
- Ratio 5:1
- New skaters are grouped first by age then by ability.
- Skaters will receive a report at the end of the program
- Private Lessons available in some programs

Progression - Pre-School & Youth Learn to Skate (Skating Levels 1 – 7)

Passed Pre-School & Youth Level 5

Can move to Beginner Hockey Power Skating Age 3+ which is held during the Learn to Skate 45 minute class or Introductory Hockey Power Skating Age 5+ which is a 1 hour class where everyone participates in hockey power skating.

Passed Pre-School & Youth Level 7 may move to CanSkate Level 3 (for Figure Skating)

Passed CanSkate Level 6 may move to Intermediate Figure Skating

* **Figure Skating** - This program is designed for the skater who has achieved the basic skating skills and would like to progress to learn more figure skating skills. Programs are 1 hour.

CanSkate Levels 3 - 7

- This program offers group lessons and 15 minutes of practice time or private lesson time.

Intermediate Figure Skating

- This program offers group lessons including private or practice
- The private or practice time is 15 or 30 minutes depending on program
- A private coach is recommended for this program.

Private Coaches

- For those skaters wishing to proceed in figure skating (CanSkate & Intermediate) and to participate in competitions, testing of dances, skills & freeskate a private coach is required.

Progression – Figure Skating

Passed PS & Y level 7 may move to CanSkate Level 3

Passed CanSkate Level 6-7 may move to Intermediate Figure Skating

* **HOCKEY POWER SKATING - Skaters First was 1st to offer Power Skating in the Town of Aurora 18 years ago.** Skaters who may wish to play hockey, ringette or speed skating in the future will be taught hockey skating skills.

In power skating, it is not enough to know how to do the skill, but how well you can do the skill.

Progression – Power Skating

Passed Beginner Hockey Power Skating may move to Introductory Power Skating (Must be age 5 & older)

Passed Introductory Power Skating may move to Intermediate Power (Must be 8 years & older)

Passed Intermediate Power Skating may move to Advanced Power (Must be 10 years & older)

Beginner Hockey Power Skating (CanPower)

This program will be offered during some of the Pre-School & Youth Learn to Skate programs. Skaters will be taught basic hockey skating skills and puck drills in a 45 minute group lesson.

- To qualify, the skater must have passed PS & Y Level 5 or the skaters must be able to skate forward, backward and attempt a controlled stop. See BPS on skating schedule

Introductory * Intermediate * Advanced Hockey Power Skating

- Each class will include a stationary and moving warm-up, a review of skills, new skills, and conditioning drills. Skaters will be placed in a level according to their needs and abilities.
- Skaters will be tested and receive a report at the end of the program

Introductory Hockey Power Skating- Age 5+

New – Full Equipment with Puck Drills

Full Equipment is optional but not required to participate in the Introductory Power. All skaters must bring a hockey stick.

- These programs are 1 hour in length. All skaters on the ice, will be participating in power skating.
- The skaters participating with full gear will learn puck drills with hockey pucks.
- Skaters who do not have full equipment will participate in puck drills using plastic hockey pucks.

Intermediate & Advanced Hockey Power

Full equipment including neck guard and mouth piece are required.

- Intermediate program requires skaters to be age 8 years old or older. 7+ if playing Rep or Select Hockey
- Advanced skaters must be age 10 and older. 9+ if playing Rep Hockey

Hockey Teams, who require power skating lessons, please contact the office

Skaters First reserves the right to move skaters to the appropriate power program according to the skaters' skills.

* Adult Skating

Beginner - Advanced Learn to Skate

- These adult programs are offered during the daytime.
- Each 1 hour session consists of a 15 minute warm-up, 15 minute group lesson, and 30 minutes of practice time
- Helmets and wrist guards are suggested for all beginner adult skaters.

Hockey Power Skating for Adults - This program is for those skaters who want to brush up on their hockey skating skills.

- Full equipment is mandatory as puck drills will be practiced during these classes. Evenings
